

- **Masks are required** for the transport of anyone who is suspected to have COVID-19
- **Quarantine** if you have been in **close contact** outside of school setting (within 6ft of someone for a cumulative total of 15 minutes or more over a 24-hour period from 48 hours prior to symptom onset) with someone who has COVID-19 OR in close contact among students in the K-12 setting as those unvaccinated students within 3 feet of an infected person for a cumulative total of 15 minutes or more over a 24-hour period from 48 hours prior to symptom onset
- The standard CDC definition of close contact (less than 6 feet apart, regardless of mask use, for a total of 15 minutes or more) applies to all unvaccinated adults, including teachers, staff, or other adults in the school setting.
- Stay home for 14 days after your last contact with a person who has COVID-19
- Shorten Quarantine Options
  - -after day 7 if you have a negative test that must occur on day 5 or later and if no symptoms reported during daily symptom monitoring
  - -after day 10 without testing and if no symptoms reported during daily symptom monitoring
- These conditions must also be met to end quarantine early: No symptoms during quarantine, and symptom monitoring until day 14
- **Isolation** is required if you are **positive for COVID-19**
- Can be around others after 10 days since symptoms first appeared AND 24 hours with no fever and symptoms are improving
- **Same household member**- quarantine begins when you are able to separate from the sick household member or when sick person has completed their 10 day isolation period
- Same household member who can separate from the sick person needs to quarantine for 14 days from their last contact with sick person or apply the 7 day or 10 day criteria to shorten quarantine
- **Exceptions to quarantine- fully vaccinated persons or persons who have tested + for COVID-19 in the last 90 days**
- **If you qualify as an exception to quarantine then you must wear a mask for 14 days when**
